2008 SUMMER FEDERAL DIRECT LOAN APPLICATION

If you want to apply for a Federal Direct Loan for summer school enrollment, you must complete the 2008-09 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), available on line at www.fafsa.ed.gov, by **March 3, 2008**. (Note that this date is earlier than the May 15 deadline established for the academic year.) Undergraduate students (except School of Continuing Studies students) must also complete the 2008-09 University of Richmond Financial Aid Supplemental Application, available at <http://financialaid.richmond.edu/forms> or at the Financial Aid office.

In addition to the applications above, this loan application must be submitted at least four weeks prior to the start of your summer session in order to receive your loan disbursement at the start of your summer session. In addition, we cannot process your loan application until you are registered for all of your summer school classes.
